In line with current Gov guidance Social distancing measures have been discontinued with the onus on personal responsibility adopted throughout our factories and offices. Floor markings which have been used for factory floors and office areas shall remain but are for guidance only. Room & area restrictions have been relaxed but the onus is on individuals to use common sense to ensure staff, customers and visitors are not put at risk. One-way systems will be encouraged to still be used to aid personal protection where possible. Staff are reminded by use of TTB and company notices of the importance of maintaining personal protection measures and to act responsibly on company premises. Office furniture will continue to be located so staff can work side by side or facing away from each other. 	 Staff, visitors, or customers that are classed as being particularly vulnerable to COVID-19 shall be asked to act responsibility and according to each individual's needs without putti ng themselves and others at risk.
